For the 2020-2021
School Year

Dear Keystone Families,

Due to the ongoing Covid- 19 pandemic, the school year at Keystone Public Schools will look different. We are considering offering two learning plans. The plans listed below are subject to change as new information on the coronavirus becomes available or as possible cases become more prevalent in the area or within our district. The health and safety of our students and employees is our top priority.

We understand you may have many questions and we will do our best to answer those questions. There may not be answers to every question right now, but we will attempt to address those questions as soon as possible. We are working on the guidelines and procedures that will be required for students who attend in person on campus. There will be more information shared soon.

One major change is that parents and visitors **will not** be allowed in any of the school buildings until further notice. Students must ride the bus or be dropped off at the cafeteria doors. If your child arrives late to school, you will need to contact the main office at 918-363-8298 upon arrival. You will be required to sign your child in. School staff will meet you at the door with the check in form. If you need to pick your child up early, you will need to call the main office at 918-363-8298 or go to the main office door and ring the doorbell. School staff will meet you at the door with the check out form. You will not be able to enter the building.

For after school car line pick up, you will need to remain in your vehicle. Do not get out of your vehicle for any reason. Please do not approach the main

office doors to pick up your child if it is after 3:15pm. Your child will be brought to your vehicle.

Other changes include, all students will have their temperature checked upon arrival at school. We are also strongly encouraging parents to take their child's temperature daily before sending them to school. **Do not send your child to school with fever.** School staff will be required to take their temperature daily prior to arrival. We are also considering the possibility of all students and staff wearing masks.

Back to school night has been canceled. Your child's teacher will be contacting you soon with back to school information, class assignment and your child's Google Classroom code.

Keystone Public Schools will be using Google Classroom for the 2020-2021 school year for all grade levels with both learning options. Students will be assigned a tablet or chromebook depending on the grade enrolled. Each student will be required to pay a nonrefundable \$25 technology fee.

We will possibly be offering two learning options for the 2020-2021 school year. **Option one** is that your child will attend in person on campus when school is in session. Tablets/ Chromebooks will be checked in and out daily, not taken home with this option. **Option two** is that your child will attend Keystone Public Schools virtually through the Google Classroom platform. Your child will be expected to attend virtual class daily and follow the regular school day schedule. Attendance will be taken for virtual learning by the classroom teacher. This option will include the same assignments as a student who is attending in person. Tablets/ Chromebooks will be checked out to the student for home use for the school year.

Please be sure to complete the parent/guardian questionnaire on our school website at www.keystonerangers.org. no later than **July 24, 2020**. Be sure to check back often for updated information.
