## Pre-K Program

### ***Requirements for Enrollment:***

1. Must be four years of age by September 1st
2. Immunization record
3. Birth certificate
4. Social Security Number
5. Proof of residence

### ***Expectations for Child Behavior:***

- Children will be expected to follow age appropriate classroom rules and routines.
- Children must be fully potty trained and able to manage their toileting needs independently.
- Children will be expected to obey the teacher.
- Children will be expected to participate in small and large group activities.
- Children are expected to use safe hands and safe bodies (no hitting, biting, or aggressive behaviors).
- Children should arrive on time and maintain consistent attendance to support their learning.



Welcome to Keystone Pre-K! We are looking forward to a wonderful school year together.

If your child is a car rider, he/she will need to be dropped off at the Pre-K building between 7:45 a.m. and 8:10 a.m. Bus riders will be escorted to our building upon arrival.

Our day begins as soon as students arrive. Children will participate in “table top” activities until we go to breakfast as a group at 8:15 a.m.

After breakfast, we begin our morning with circle time and whole-group literacy learning. We incorporate a brain break to keep our bodies moving and minds focused before transitioning into morning learning center rotations. During this time, students engage in hands-on activities designed to strengthen their literacy and math skills. The teacher leads small group instruction during one of the center rotations to provide targeted, individualized learning opportunities.

Lunch is served at 11:00 a.m., followed by lunch recess. After recess, our class transitions into a rest and recuperation period. Our days are packed with fun activities and “hard” work, so this quiet time allows students to recharge. Children are not required to sleep but are expected to lie quietly and rest. Each child will need a rest mat and a beach towel or small blanket to rest comfortably. We will enjoy a small snack after rest time.

Our school day ends at 3:10 p.m. Car riders will be picked up in front of the main office, and a teacher will assist students into your vehicle. Bus riders will be escorted to their buses to go home.
